Eligibility Requirements

- Be a highly motivated current or former foster youth, between the ages of 17 and 25, who demonstrates academic potential

- Qualify for "Independent Student" status under federal financial aid guidelines
- Apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>FAFSA Website</u>, or the California Dream Act application at <u>California Dream Act Application</u>, by the priority filing date, March 2nd
- As a first time freshman, be available to participate in the EOP Summer Bridge Program
- Apply for Cal Grant by completing the Cal Grant GPA Verification Form at <u>CSAC Website</u> by March 2nd
- If in foster care between the ages of 16-18, apply for the Chaffey Grant at Chafee Website
