FAQ

- How long has CSUSB been associated with the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (H.A.C.U.)?
 - O CSUSB has been a member of HACU since 1991.
- When did CSUSB first receive the US Department of Education's distinction as a Hispanic Serving Institution (H.S.I., >25% Hispanic undergraduate enrollment)?
 - CSUSB first received it's distinction as an HSI in 1994 and has received that distinction every year since.
- When did CSUSB first qualify to be eligible for Title V programs under the US Department of Education (significant low-income student enrollment, ≥25% Hispanic undergraduate enrollment)?
 - o CSUSB has been Title V eligible since 1994, and renews its eligibility annually.
- When did CSUSB first receive the US Department of Education's distinction as having "High Hispanic Enrollment" (>25% Hispanic undergraduate enrollment)?
 - CSUSB has received the USDE distinction as a High Hispanic Enrolling institution since the inception of that program in 2006.
- When did CSUSB first qualify for the US Department of Education's distinction as a Minority Serving Institution (M.S.I., ≥ 50% undergraduate enrollment comprised of African American, Hispanic American, Native American, US Pacific Islander students)?
 - According to IPEDS reported data, CSUSB has qualified as an MSI institution since 2009.
