

## FAQ

- How long has CSUSB been associated with the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (H.A.C.U.)?
  - **CSUSB has been a member of HACU since 1991.**
- When did CSUSB first receive the US Department of Education's distinction as a Hispanic Serving Institution (H.S.I.,  $\geq 25\%$  Hispanic undergraduate enrollment)?
  - **CSUSB first received its distinction as an HSI in 1994 and has received that distinction every year since.**
- When did CSUSB first qualify to be eligible for Title V programs under the US Department of Education (significant low-income student enrollment,  $\geq 25\%$  Hispanic undergraduate enrollment)?
  - **CSUSB has been Title V eligible since 1994, and renews its eligibility annually.**
- When did CSUSB first receive the US Department of Education's distinction as having "High Hispanic Enrollment" ( $> 25\%$  Hispanic undergraduate enrollment)?
  - **CSUSB has received the USDE distinction as a High Hispanic Enrolling institution since the inception of that program in 2006.**
- When did CSUSB first qualify for the US Department of Education's distinction as a Minority Serving Institution (M.S.I.,  $\geq 50\%$  undergraduate enrollment comprised of African American, Hispanic American, Native American, US Pacific Islander students)?
  - **According to IPEDS reported data, CSUSB has qualified as an MSI institution since 2009.**
