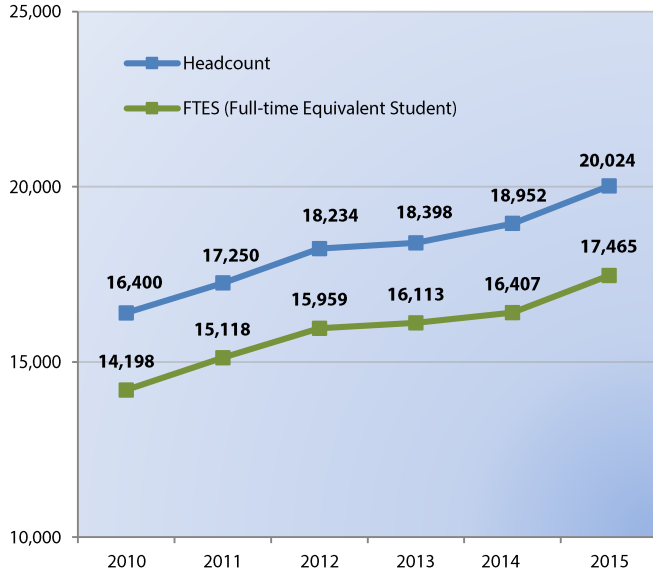

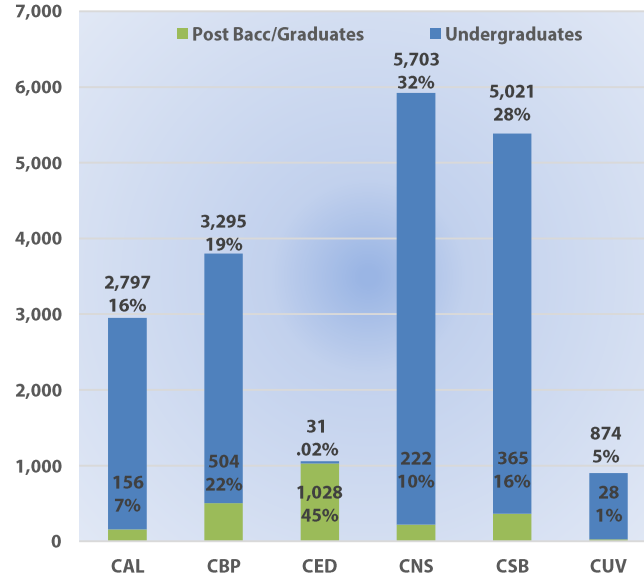

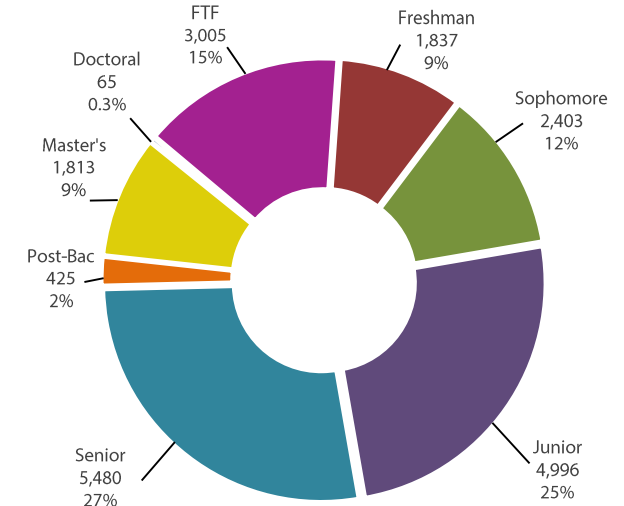
### Headcount & FTES Fall 2010-2015



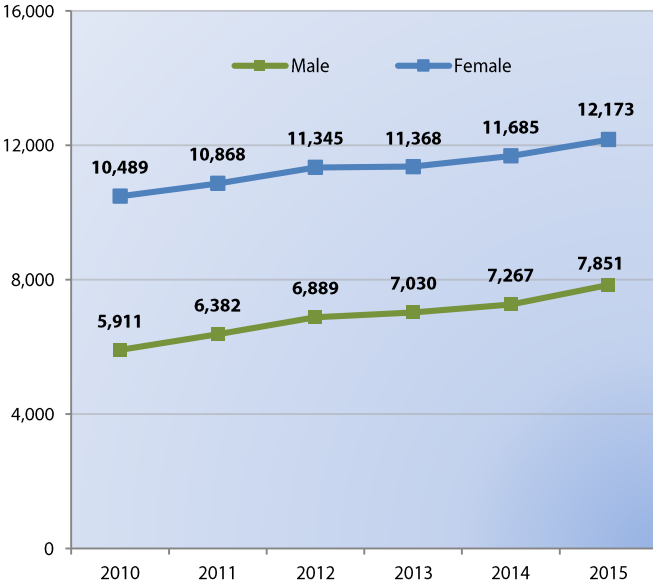
### Headcount by College of Major Fall 2015



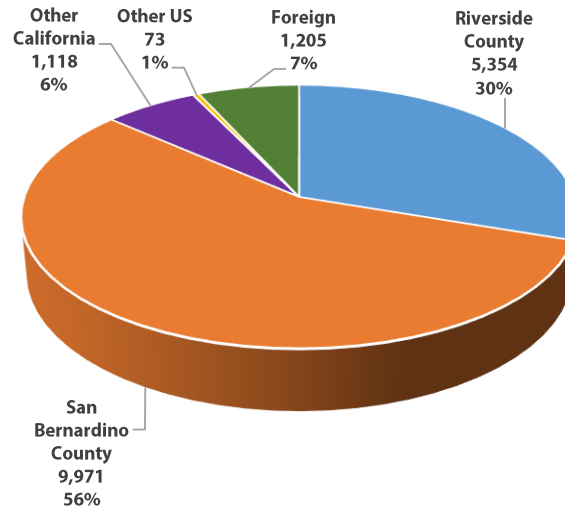
### Headcount by Student Level Fall 2015



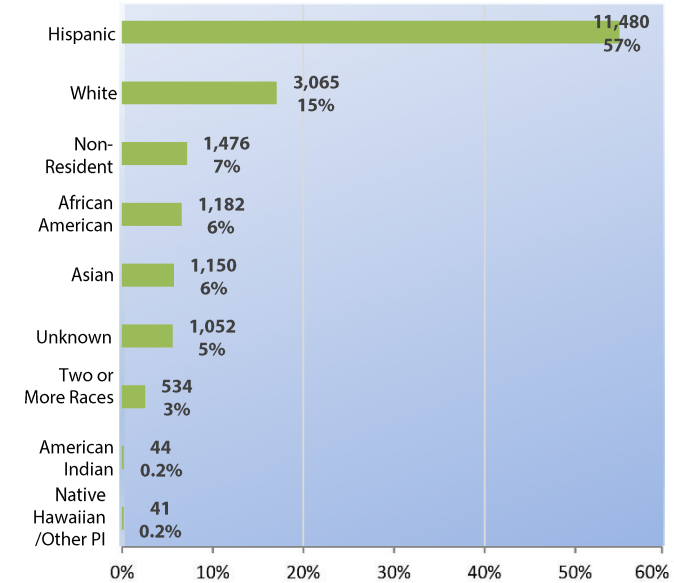
### Headcount by Gender Fall 2010-2015
