Recommendation to Merge Graduation Check and Commencement Registration Fees

The Divisions of Administration and Finance and Student Affairs recommend that two CSU category 4 fees, Graduation Check and Commencement Registration, be merged and paid together at a rate of \$75 at the point a student files their first Graduation Check. Currently, the fee for the first Graduation Check is \$25 and Commencement Registration is \$50.

This is recommended to be implemented September 15, 2017. Additional Graduation Check fees for refiling at \$20 and/or for filing late at \$20 are in addition to the base fee.

The advantages of this recommendation are as follows:

- It relieves the student from having to complete multiple administrative processes on different timelines to graduate from the University.
- It relieves the University from costs and staff time associated with processing approximately 5,000 transactions a year.
- It ensures that the costs associated with hosting commencement ceremonies in both Fall and Spring are equally shared amongst graduating students.
- It closes a sizeable budget gap for the commencement ceremonies and relieves the General Fund from this obligation.

Students who filed and paid their first Graduation Check fee prior to September 1, 2017 will need to pay the additional Commencement Registration Fee to participate in commencement ceremonies.
