SUMMARY OF FINDINGS:

HEARING PROCEDURES / GUIDELINES:

Reviewing officer will need to complete the following, see below:

VC 14602.6. (a) (1) Whenever a peace officer determines that a person was driving a **vehicle** while his or her driving privilege was suspended or revoked, driving a **vehicle** while his or her driving privilege is restricted pursuant to Section 13352 or 23575 and the **vehicle** is not equipped with a functioning, certified interlock device, or driving a **vehicle** without ever having been issued a driver's license, the peace officer may either immediately arrest that person and cause the removal and seizure of that **vehicle** or, if the **vehicle** is involved in a traffic collision, cause the removal and seizure of the **vehicle** without the necessity of arresting the person in accordance with Chapter 10 (commencing with Section 22650) of Division 11. A **vehicle** so impounded shall be impounded for 30 days.

2. Confirm driver has current DL and have dispatch place into the report.
3. Early Release Agreement Letter.
4. Photocopy any DMV paperwork provided.

VC 14607.6. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and except as provided in this section, a motor **vehicle** is subject to forfeiture as a nuisance if it is driven on a highway in this state by a driver with a suspended or revoked license, or by an unlicensed driver, who is a registered owner of the **vehicle** at the time of impoundment and has a previous misdemeanor conviction for a violation of subdivision (a) of Section 12500 or Section 14601, 14601.1, 14601.2, 14601.3, 14601.4, or 14601.5.
