

2-YEAR TRANSFER PLAN for PSYCHOLOGY MAJORS

The following plan assumes that transfer students have completed 2 years of full time course work (approximately 91 quarter units) prior to transferring to CSUSB. This includes 66 units of lower division general education requirements (including PSYC 100, PSYC 105, and PSYC 115), the equivalent of psychological statistics, and 20 units of lower-division electives.

Year One at CSUSB [45 Units]

1.	PSYC 101 (1)
2.	PSYC 311 (6)
3.	SSCI 306 (4)
4.	<i>Eight units</i> from the “ <i>Fields of Psychology</i> ” section of the psychology major
5.	<i>Eight units</i> from the “ <i>Basic Processes</i> ” section of the psychology major
6.	<i>Eight units</i> from Category B5, C5, or D5 (Integrative Capstone of the General Education Requirements)
7.	<i>Four units</i> of upper-division psychology electives
8.	<i>Six units</i> of free electives, chosen from any courses offered at the university.

Year Two at CSUSB [44 Units]

1.	<i>Six to eight units</i> from the “ <i>Advanced Cumulating Experience</i> ” section of the psychology major. Choose between the <i>Experimental Lab</i> series (6 units) or the <i>Seminar</i> series (4 units). Students taking the <i>Seminar</i> series will also take PSYC 357 (4 units.).
2.	<i>Four units</i> from the “ <i>Fields of Psychology</i> ” section of the psychology major
3.	<i>Four units</i> from the “ <i>Basic Processes</i> ” section of the psychology major
4.	<i>Four units</i> from the “ <i>Applications</i> ” section of the psychology major
5.	<i>Four units</i> from Category B5, C5, or D5 (Integrative Capstone of the General Education Requirements)
6.	<i>Twelve units</i> of upper-division psychology electives
7.	<i>Ten to Twelve units</i> of free electives, chosen from any courses offered at the university.
