## Important Notes for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Reporting:

1. Please be advised that these figures only cover grants and contracts reviewed and submitted through the Office of Research & Sponsored Programs.
2. "Awarded" dollars are those as stated on received award documents, from which grant account budgets are constructed, and thus were dollars available for expenditure in FY 2014-15. The Cumulative Awards totals include (1) new awards, (2) renewals of existing multi-year awards, and (3) program income generated from existing awards. Those three types of awarded monies are reported separately in the following tables. Actual grant expenditures in FY 2014-15 are available through Sponsored Programs Administration, pending final annual audits.
3. The manner in which "Submitted" grant and contract proposals are counted was changed in FY 2012-2013. The changes involved modifying the ORSP data base, data entry protocol, and award reporting. The result is a more accurate tabulation of newly submitted proposals during the fiscal year, as well as a more detailed breakdown by type of award (new, renewals, and program income).
