Important Notes & Description of Changes for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Reporting:

1. Please be advised that these figures only cover grants and contracts reviewed and submitted through the Office of Research & Sponsored Programs.
2. "Awarded" dollars are those as stated on received award documents, from which grant account budgets are constructed, and thus were dollars available for expenditure in FY 2012-13. The Cumulative Awards totals include (1) new awards, (2) renewals of existing multi-year awards, and (3) program income generated from existing awards. Those three types of awarded monies are reported separately in the following tables. Actual grant expenditures in FY 2012-13 are available through Sponsored Programs Administration, pending final annual audits.
3. The manner in which "Submitted" grant and contract proposals are counted has been changed for FY 2012-2013. The changes involved modifying the ORSP data base, data entry protocol, and award reporting. The result is a more accurate tabulation of newly submitted proposals during the fiscal year, as well as a more detailed breakdown by type of award (new, renewals, and program income). For this report, we have manually calculated the number of new submissions made during FY 2011-2012 using the same method for the FY 12-13 data to provide a basis for comparison. Please note, that the awards have not been previously broken down into the three categories; thus, there are no comparable data for the prior fiscal year provided in tables 1B and 1D.
