 - The VP of Finance hosted an open forum in which he shared that the University is currently in a structural deficit. Unit 3 salary increases are in progress for Lecturers. Lecturer L (range 1) has been eliminated and will now be moved to Lecturer A (Range 2). Adjunct faculty appointed as Lecture A with a terminal degree in their teaching discipline will be converted to Lecture B (Range 3). All faculty unit employees shall receive a GSI salary increase.
 - A quick reference guide for faculty recruitment was distributed. Academic Personnel is requesting that staff follow the guidelines for the submission of hiring documents. Additionally, it is required for Deans and Chairs to add faculty startup commitments.
