Campus Security Authority Mandatory Reporter ARE YOU A CSA?

An official of an institution who has significant responsibility for student and campus activities, including but not limited to, student housing, student discipline, and campus judicial procedures. Individuals may be designated as CSA's if their official job responsibilities involve interaction with student and/or campus activities; serve as formal or unofficial mentors to students; serve as a member in an office or on a committee to whom students are instructed or informed to report or discuss crimes, allegations of crimes, or have oversight for disciplinary procedures.

- Parking and Transportation (under UPD) Officers and Community Service Officers (CSOs)
- Housing & Residential Education staff, including Assistant
 Directors, Area Coordinators, and Resident Assistants

- Student Conduct & Ethical Development personnel
- Title IX & Gender Equity personnel
- Club and Organizations Advisors
- Dean of Students
- Study Abroad Coordinators
- Ombudspersons
- Victim Advocates
- Management Personnel Plan (MPPs) Employees
- Campus Administrators (e.g. President, Vice Presidents, Associate Vice Presidents)
