The student may also research and analyze information, make recommendations, creatively apply related skills and specialized experience.</li> <li>• The student may assign, review, or monitor the work of other student employees</li> <li>• Require minimal supervision</li> </ul>		
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<b>Pay Rate Increases</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Supervisors may award longevity or pay rate increases to students at the completion of an academic term provided the student has performed satisfactorily in his or her work assignment and is returning for the subsequent quarter or term</li><li>• Requests to be submitted to SET coordinator on PS/Change/Correction form.
