


## ASSESSMENT FOLLOW-UP REPORT RISK MANAGEMENT - WORKERS' COMPENSATION TIMELY REPORT

There is a significant decrease in the number of new workers' compensation cases and a slight improvement in the timely reporting rate. The University had 49 new workers' compensation cases in fiscal year 2019/2020, which is 12 cases less than last fiscal year. 94% of these cases were reported within 5 business days. For eight months out of the year, the University achieved 100% timely reporting of work-related injuries. Compared with fiscal year 2018/2019, the university increased the timely reporting rate by 2% and decreased the total new cases number by 20%,



The practices the University implemented over the 2019/2020 Fiscal Year were:

- Educated staff on the importance of timely reporting of all injuries
- Sent follow-up emails to the Supervisors after receipt of Supervisor's Injury Investigation Reports
- Educated supervisor during one on one discussion on timely reporting.
