




myCAP – myCoyote Academic Planner



HOW TO BUILD YOUR myCAP

- Click on course selections with a red X (needs to be taken) to view additional details.
- Drag and drop course selections from the PAWS side to the appropriate term in myCAP (term must turn blue to drop into section).
- Courses can also be moved within terms.
- Add courses not listed on your PAWS with the Add Course button under each term.

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
